



HARRIS COUNTY ANNOUNCES \$30 MILLION GRANT PROGRAM TO ASSIST SMALL BUSINESSES IMPACTED BY COVID-19

Harris County commissioners approved the \$30 million Small Business Recovery Fund (SBRF) designed to help small businesses that have not received COVID-19 relief.

The grant program will be established with federal funding Harris County received through the CARES Act and will allocate \$30 million in available funding to small businesses, including nonprofits. Maximum grant awards are \$25,000 per applicant. The funds can be used for payroll costs, rent, accounts payable, and other operating expenses.

The program will launch July 13 at 8 a.m. and will remain open for 10 days, through July 22. More detailed information regarding eligibility requirements, how to access the application online and over the phone, and what residents will need to prepare for the application, will be released in the coming week.

The SBRF will be available to small businesses in Harris County with 30 or fewer employees. Applicants must also have been in business for the entire 2019 calendar year in order to be eligible.

Businesses that previously received COVID-19 relief through the Paycheck Protection Program, Harris County's LEAP small business loan program, and other financial relief programs are still eligible for the new Harris County grant program. However, priority will be given to businesses that have not yet been approved for other assistance programs.
